1. Do you have the parents on site?

Yes, both the dam and sire are onsite and part of our family of Brittany's.

2. What is the process of reserving a puppy?

The total cost of puppies is \$1000/each (Subject to change)

Payment Mode would be as follows:

Step 1: Upon reservation a non-refundable fee of \$100 would be required to be put on a list for a Mazeppa Brittany. Here you would also be required to inform us about the sex and color preferred.

Step 2: Once you have picked your puppy from the ones available, an additional payment of \$400 will be due for payment.

Step 3: The remaining balance of \$500 will be payable once you pick up your puppy.

3. What is included with the price of the puppy?

Included with your puppy is a minimum of 3 dewormings, tails docked and removal of dewclaws, first puppy shots and 6 week vet checks along with AKC registration papers. We also send a small bag of Purina ProPlan Puppy Food to help the adoptive parents transition the puppy to the food of their choice.

4. Are your dogs specifically bred to hunt?

Not only do our dogs excel in the field but also are wonderful family dogs. We take pride in breeding the best of both worlds. Thus, the Brittany's you get from us are not only great hunters but also gentle with children.

5. How big do they get?

An average male can grow up to 35-40 lbs, and females up to 30-35lbs.

6. What are the colors of puppies you produce?

- 1) Traditional Orange/White
- 2) Tri-color (Liver/Orange/White)
- 3) Orange and Tri-color Roan.

7. How do you train your puppies for Socialization?

Our puppies are frequently played with by our grandchildren as well as with our family. Also, you can include reference to the fact that we have been breeding top quality Brittany's for over 18 years and our 2 breeding pairs are part of our family. We only breed Brittany's and we do it because we love the breed.
